

Rules and Instructions for Candidates

- Candidates must arrive at the examination room at least **15 minutes before the scheduled start time** of the test. **No candidate will be permitted to enter once the examination has started.**
- Access to the examination room is **strictly limited to candidates who have been officially summoned.**
- Each candidate must sit in the **assigned examination room and seat/number** and must comply with the designated arrangements.
- Candidates must be in possession of their **National Identity Card (CNI)** and present it to the examination supervisors upon request.
- All personal belongings, including documents, switched-off mobile phones, and any other communication devices, must be placed **away from the candidate's workspace and out of reach** for the duration of the examination.
- Candidates are **strictly prohibited from sharing or exchanging any materials or supplies** (including pens, pencils, erasers, rulers, correction fluid, calculators, or any other items) during the examination.
- The use of **mobile phones, smartwatches, electronic devices, or any means of communication, storage, or information access** is strictly forbidden throughout the entire examination period.
- Any attempt to cheat, as well as any refusal to comply with the instructions provided by examination supervisors, will result in the **immediate removal of the candidate from the examination** and the application of the sanctions prescribed by the regulations in force.
